

Associate Professor Graham Gumley is the Head of the Macquarie Hand Unit with prior appointments with Harvard and Boston Universities, and is the former vice chairman of Orthopaedics at the Lahey Clinic, Boston and Director of the Sihanouk Hospital Center of HOPE in Phnom Penh. He will host the evening and introduce his specialist colleagues.

DR MARK RIDER

FRCS, FRCS (Plas), FRACS

Dr Mark Rider is a qualified Plastic Surgeon who manages all soft tissue and bone problems in the hand with a particular interest in peripheral nerve surgery and reconstruction following trauma.

Dr Mark Rider will be discussing hand injuries, with an emphasis on primary management and referral guidelines.

DR NICHOLAS SMITH

FRACS, FAOrthA

Dr Nicholas Smith is an Orthopaedic background Hand Surgeon whose interests include hand and wrist surgery, particularly wrist arthroscopy, thumb arthritis and congenital hand surgery.

Dr Nicholas Smith will be discussing arthritic conditions of the hand, particularly the base of the thumb.

DR ANNE WAJON

CHT, BAppSc (Phy), PhD

Dr Anne Wajon is a physiotherapist with several years experience in treating the hand and upper limb. She has hand therapy practices at Hornsby and Dee Why, and in 2010 joined Prof Gumley to set up the Macquarie Hand Unit. Anne enjoys the clinical and academic aspects of hand therapy and completed her PhD on the management of carpometacarpal osteoarthritis in 2006.

Dr Wajon will be discussing an evidence-based approach to the diagnosis and conservative management of carpometacarpal osteoarthritis, and will demonstrate various splinting alternatives for the management of this condition.

DR MICHAEL DOWD

MB, BS (Hons1), BSc, DipHandSurg, FRACS

Dr Michael Dowd FRACS is a fully qualified Plastic Surgeon who is a member of the Australian Hand Surgery Society and The NSW Hand Association. He has a special interest in hand surgery and his main interests are in soft tissue disorders of the hand such as carpal tunnel syndrome, Dupuytren's Disease, trigger finger, lumps in the hand, mucous cysts, ganglions, arthritis and De Quervain's Disease.

Dr Dowd will be discussing Dupuytren's Contracture and other soft tissue problems of the hand.
