

ORTHOPAEDICS SERVICES AT MACQUARIE UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL

The Australian School of Advanced Medicine, located beside the hospital, is the first medical school in Australia to be linked to a private teaching hospital on a university campus. Together the co-located facilities offer an integrated approach to clinical care, teaching and research. ASAM provides post-fellowship, subspecialty training in medicine and surgery as well as higher research degrees.

The current orthopaedic disciplines and services offered include arthroplasty, sports medicine, knee, shoulder and elbow surgery. All consultants appointed to this institution were chosen based on their reputation and skill and bring with them an enormous depth and breadth of competence and knowledge.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR DES BOKOR

Associate Professor Des Bokor is an Orthopaedic Surgeon with a subspecialty interest in shoulder and elbow surgery. He graduated from Monash University in Melbourne with honours and completed his orthopaedic training in Sydney through the Australian Orthopaedic Association training program. Following this, he completed fellowships in sports medicine/ knee surgery in Sydney and then spent time at the University of Western Ontario, Canada, as a fellow training in shoulder surgery. He has a Master of Higher Education (Medical) from Macquarie University. Associate Professor Bokor is a founding member of the Shoulder and Elbow Society of Australia and a member of the American Shoulder and Elbow Surgeons Society, the Australian Orthopaedic Association, the Australian Medical Association and Sports Medicine Australia. He is a sub-editor for the Journal of Shoulder and Elbow Surgery. He is also currently Associate Professor and Chair of the Section of Orthopaedics at the Australian School of Advanced Medicine at Macquarie University and Macquarie University Hospital.

DR MUNJED AL MUDERIS

Dr Al Muderis is an Orthopaedic Surgeon and a clinical lecturer at Macquarie University and The Australian School Of Advanced Medicine, specialising in Hip, Knee and Trauma surgery for the Adult and Paediatric population. He has special expertise in hip arthroscopy, for femoral-acetabular impingement syndrome as well as soft tissue damage to the hip. Dr Al Muderis has formal training in Europe on the anterior approach total hip replacement which is gaining significant popularity worldwide. He also has special interest in ACL reconstruction using anatomy preserving technology and total knee replacement using computerised navigation technology. Dr Al Muderis is one of a handful of surgeons world-wide who has a special expertise in trans-femoral and trans-humeral amputations, providing patients with robotic artificial limbs using transcutaneous osseointegrated technology. This is designed to be as close to the human anatomy as possible. Dr Al Muderis is a Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons, Australian Orthopaedic Association, International Society for Hip Arthroscopy and the Orthopaedic Surgical Osseointegration Society.

DR ALI GURSEL

Dr Ali Gursel is an Orthopaedic Surgeon with interests in surgery of the Hip and Knee; Arthroscopic, Joint Replacement and Revision surgery. He is a former member of the Hip Advisory Committee, a current member of Standards Australia, the Arthroplasty Society of Australia and the Hip Arthroscopy Society. Dr Gursel graduated from UNSW with honours in 1992 and spent his junior years at Concord Repatriation Hospital. He commenced his AOA accredited orthopaedic training with the Sydney Northside Scheme and obtained his Orthopaedic Fellowship (FRACS) in 2001. This was followed by arthroplasty fellowships in the UK and Australia. He is an Associate of Specialty Orthopaedics based at Parramatta and consults at Macquarie University Clinic and Macquarie University Hospital.

DR RICHARD BOYLE

Dr Richard Boyle is a specialist Orthopaedic Surgeon and Musculoskeletal Tumour Surgeon. He graduated with honours in medicine from UNSW and completed his Orthopaedic training in Sydney at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital, and thence internationally in Toronto Canada, Basel Switzerland, and Vienna Austria. He has a particular interest in Hip and Knee Replacement, complex Revision surgery, and Bone and Soft Tissue Tumour surgery, especially biological reconstruction and advanced joint replacement techniques, including computer navigation and patient specific surgery. He is a Fellow of the Australian Orthopaedic Association and is the current Director of Orthopaedic Training at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital, member of the Northside Board of Studies and New South Wales Regional Training committee. He is a member of the Australian Sarcoma Group, the Australian Sarcoma Study Group, and The New South Wales Oncology Group. He is a consultant surgeon at the weekly New South Wales Bone and Soft Tissue Tumour Meeting and is involved in a number of clinical trials for tumour treatment. He is also a clinical Lecturer at The Australian School of Advanced Medicine, Macquarie University, and is involved with postgraduate medical training through Sydney University. His practice encompasses Macquarie University Hospital, North Shore Private Hospital, Royal Prince Alfred Hospital, The Institute of Rheumatology and Orthopaedics, and The Children's Hospital Westmead.
