

He is the Head of Rhinology and Skull Base Surgery at the Applied Medical Research Centre of UNSW and is an Associate Professor at both the University of NSW and Macquarie University. After several years of post-training fellowships, including formal fellowships in the USA and UK, Associate Professor Harvey now practices in Sydney as one of only a few dedicated rhinologists in the country.

He has authored over 100 publications, abstracts and book chapters and currently sits on the editorial board for the Rhinology Journal and the International Forum of Allergy and Rhinology. Associate Professor Harvey is an associate editor for the American Journal of Rhinology and Allergy and is actively involved in research programs in Sydney. He runs a series of courses with St Vincent's Hospital every year to further rhinologic education and training in Australia.
