

THE SPECIALISTS

PROFESSOR GEOFFREY WHITE

Professor Geoffrey White is the head of the department and Professor of vascular surgery at Macquarie University Hospital, and Clinical Associate professor of surgery, University of Sydney. He completed his specialty training at RPA before working in the U.S.A for five years as a vascular surgeon, with involvement also in trauma surgery and transplantation. He has a particular interest in the development of medical devices and also in clinical aspect of less-invasive treatments for vascular disorders. He has published two textbooks on vascular treatment, as well as authoring more than 75 book chapters and 150 published research papers in medical journals.

Professor White will be speaking on percutaneous management of advanced peripheral occlusive disease.

DR IRWIN MOHAN

Dr Irwin Mohan is a vascular surgeon. He carried out his training at major vascular units in the United Kingdom, including St Mary's Hospital, London; Edinburgh Royal Infirmary, and the Royal Liverpool University Hospital. He was appointed as a consultant vascular surgeon at Manchester Royal Infirmary from 2001 to 2006, and undertook further training in endovascular techniques in Sydney, Australia. In 2006 he relocated to Australia. He is a Clinical Senior Lecturer with the University of Sydney. Dr Mohan continues to be an examiner with the European Board of Vascular Surgery Qualifications, and also for the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons. Dr Mohan did research at Imperial College, University of London for a doctor of medicine research degree (MD) into peripheral arterial disease, homocysteine and platelet function. He serves as a reviewer for a number of international medical journals and has many publications in the field of vascular and endovascular surgery.

Dr Irwin Mohan will be speaking on carotid artery disease.

DR MICHAEL STEPHEN

Dr Michael Stephen is a vascular surgeon of more than 20 years at the Royal Prince Alfred, Mater and Strathfield Private Hospitals and Macquarie University Hospital. His areas of interest include minimally invasive treatment of aneurysms (abdominal and thoracic), carotid disease, peripheral vascular disease, renovascular hypertension. His specific area of expertise includes vascular reconstruction in association with extensive malignancy.

Dr Stephen will be speaking aneurysms and the revolution of endovascular repair.

DR RAFFI QASABIAN

Dr Raffi Qasabian is a vascular and endovascular surgeon at Macquarie University Hospital. He is a member of the Australian and New Zealand Society of Vascular Surgeons, and has been newly appointed to the NSW Regional Committee of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons. He is a lecturer and co-ordinator of the surgical course for 3rd year medical students at the Central Clinical School of the University of Sydney. Following completion of his surgical studies in Australia, Dr Qasabian undertook a Fellowship year at St Thomas' Hospital in London, where he gained valuable experience in open and endovascular surgical techniques. Since returning to Sydney, he has established a practice in vascular surgery with a particular interest in: aneurysm disease, carotid artery surgery, peripheral arterial disease (PAD), diabetic feet, varicose vein surgery and minimally invasive vascular interventions.

Dr Qasabian will be speaking on varicose veins and hyperhidrosis.

DR WALID MOHABBAT

Dr Walid Mohabbat is a vascular surgeon who completed training with the RACS and then spent 2 years in the Cleveland Clinic USA in subspecialty training. He specialises in endovascular stentgraft repairs for aortic aneurysms and dissections including fenestrated and branched repairs, carotid endarterectomy and carotid artery stenting, lower extremity endovascular treatments including angioplasty, stenting, laser arthroectomy and also in endovenous laser ablation of varicose veins.
